


## The Resurrection of Jesus

Some might say that no matter what the evidence, it is hard to believe in a resurrection of the body. Of any ordinary man it would be extremely hard to believe. But not only did Jesus live and speak like no other man, but he was also foretold in striking, fulfilled prophecies. He predicted his resurrection before his death, and birthed a world-wide movement that changed the day of worship from Saturday to Sunday. The apostle Paul rested the truth of Christianity squarely on the truth of the resurrection of Christ in 1 Corinthians 15. Since the founders of all other religions are resting in their graves, it is only prudent to examine with sober care the claims of the solitary figure who changed history on the basis of his resurrection – which validates all that he taught and did relating to God, man, and hope for our mortal, ruined condition.



Dr. Habermas presents his excellent presentation on the resurrection which does not assume the inspiration of scripture or even the historical accuracy of the entire New Testament or the Gospels. Rather, just working from the facts that skeptical scholars accept, he demonstrates the compelling evidence for the resurrection of Jesus.

★ 2:36 Dr. Habermas goes too far with the evidence at this one point. Calling Jesus “Lord” is compatible with the Deity of Christ. However, it is not a proof of deity, since “Lord” can be used in different senses. For example, in Psalm 110:1, the most quoted Old Testament verse in the New Testament, “LORD” (Adonai – used for God) is distinguished from “Lord” (adoni, “my Lord” - always used for non-deity lords). The New King James version of the Bible does a commendable job of indicating the distinction between LORD and Lord even in the New Testament quotations of Old Testament verses. Most translations don’t indicate the distinction.
